This term we are going back in time!

<p>English</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reading fluently and answering questions about what they have read.- Making predictions about events in a book.- Learning how to write a formal letter.- Creating a shape poem.- Writing a narrative. <p>*Handwriting is very important in Y3 – if you could encourage your child to form their letters correctly and neatly when they are writing at home it will consolidate what they have learnt at school*</p>	<p>Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Learning number bonds to 20.- Counting in steps 2,3 and 5.- Adding and subtracting mentally 3 digits and ones, tens and hundreds.- Finding 10 & 100 more of a given number.- Learning the number of days in a week, month & a year.- Counting, comparing & ordering numbers to 1000.- Adding and subtracting mentally 3 digits and hundreds.- Addition of 2 digit numbers - formal method (Carrying numbers)- Telling the time to minutes & seconds.- Drawing and recognising 2D shapes.	<p>Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Comparing and classifying rocks based on their appearance and note their changes over time.- Discussing how fossils are formed and what living organism may have lived there previously.- Discussing and stating how things move on different surfaces.- Forces, looking at pulling and pushing
<p>Phonics/SPaG</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Learning suffixes (word endings such as – less, -ness, -ful, -ly & -ment).- Learning prefixes (word beginnings) such as - un, dis, miss & in.- Using punctuation correctly including the use of commas in a list.Using similes & metaphors in writing.	<p>PE</p> <p>Please ensure your child has their full PE kit in school Monday to Friday as PE days sometimes change at short notice.</p> <p>Children may wear jogging bottoms for outdoor PE.</p>	<p>History</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- This term we will be exploring and discussing changes in Britain from the Stone Age.- Naming significant events from the Stone Age period.- Understanding historical enquiries and chronologically ordering artefacts from these periods of time.
<p>RSHE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- We will be talking about what makes a good friend and how we can be a better friend. <p>RE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- We will be discussing the similarities and differences between different ideas about God.	<p>Art</p> <p>We will be looking at cave art and the methods and materials that were used.</p> <p>We will also be looking at the difference between sketching and drawing and the skills needed.</p>	<p>Spellings</p> <p>Spelling tests are each Monday. Children are encouraged to practise these spellings at home multiple times. These words will follow a spelling rule that has been taught in school. The test will consist of 5 words from the list and 5 unseen words that follow that week's rule.</p>
