Maths

- 2x, 5x and 10x tables
- Recapping Place Value
- Subtraction (2 digit take tens; 2 digit take 2 digit)
- Inverse and missing number problems.
- 2D/3D shapes and their properties
- Multiplication
- Division (by 0, 1, 2, 5 and 10)
- Fractions (whole, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{2}{3}$, $\frac{3}{4}$) of a shape or amount.

SPaG

We are focussing on basic punctuation, word classes, expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, contractions and sentence types.
