Y1 - Summer Term 2 – 2021

This term we are travelling the world!

English

This term we are going to be reading about the fictional Paddington Bear!

We will be:

- using adjectives to write sentences to describe what Paddington Bear looks like and his personality.
- creating our own story about Paddington Bear travelling around the UK.
- creating our character and writing about them travelling around the world.
- learning and reciting poetry!

Maths

- Recap:

- The name of 2D and 3D shapes
 - Sharing a number of objects equally between groups
 - Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- find a half of different shapes and amounts.
- find a quarter of different shapes and amounts.
- learn how to tell the time to the hour and half hour.
- measure and compare times.
- describe position and direction.

Geography

We will:

- learn all about the countries found in the UK and what their capital cities are.
- recognise the flags of the countries in the UK.
- learn what a continent is.
- Identify that there are 7 continent and name them all.
- learn that an ocean is a large area of salt water and name the 5 oceans.



Handwriting & Letter Formation

Handwriting is very important in Y1 – if you could encourage your child to form their letters correctly and neatly when they are writing at home it will consolidate what they have learnt at school.

To support this, we will be going to the 'Dough Disco' each day to strengthen our finger muscles!
